Seeing your Life through the Lens of the Gospel Luke 15:1-32

- There are three figures in the story of the Prodigal Son. The father is a symbol of an unconditonal love. Perhaps you can recall someone showing love to you in a way that showed great forgiveness and acceptance. Have there been times when you have also loved in this way?
- 2. You may be able to identify with the younger son at different stages of his journey. Be sure to follow it to the point where it becomes a good news story for you – when you 'came to yourself.' Where and when have you experienced a homecoming after a time of exile and alienation.
