Thoughts on receiving the Precious Blood from the Chalice

We have the opportunity in this Parish to receive from the chalice as well as the host. Holy Communion under both kinds shows more clearly the meal aspect of the Eucharist - "TAKE AND EAT - TAKE AND DRINK ". The grace of God is communicated to us powerfully in the reception of this Sacrament.

One of the Church documents encouraging the use of the chalice simply says – "The Cup is necessary for the fullness of the sign".

Pope John XXIII once said a remarkable thing too – "The most sacred and mysterious part of the Eucharistic Liturgy centres round the chalice of Jesus which contains his precious blood."

It is sometimes easy for us to approach the altar not really fully aware of what we are doing or what we are about. Holy Communion under both kinds challenges us to be more awake and alert, and to be conscious of the difference of the Host and the Chalice. The Host is especially the sign of our involvement with one another in the body of Christ. We can see the chalice or the cup as the sign of Christ's love on the Cross. And so, THINK about the rich meaning of Holy Communion UNDER BOTH KINDS.
