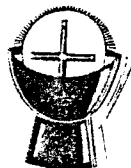

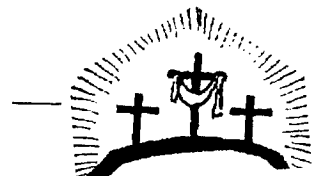

Thank you to our team of volunteers who cleaned, marked out the Church to ensure social distancing and organised the opening of OUR CHURCH following the huge documents of guidance and regulations we were given.

Our first opening for Private Prayer was wonderful yesterday – Friday Afternoon. It was lovely to see over 30 visitors who welcomed the opportunity to visit Church for prayer for the first time in three months.

We plan to open again for Private Prayer on Wednesday 24th between 10.00AM and 12Noon and between 6-00PM and 7-00PM – and Friday between 2-00PM and 4-00PM.

Whilst the experience is not what parishioners are used to it is all we can do at present in making sure everyone is safe following guidelines from the Archdiocese of Birmingham and the UK government. We know not being able to sit where you choose or in your usual seat is not ideal. We have to monitor where people have sat to effectively clean the area. We have to ensure that everyone is at a social distance. Following the instructions of our stewards and the one way system ensures social distancing is adhered too especially as we only have one door [level floor] used for both entrance and exit.

Please can you wear a face mask or face covering if possible.

If you or anyone in your family has symptoms please stay at home.

We would be really grateful If you develop symptoms within 2 weeks of your visit if you or a member of your family contact Fr Des. This ensures we follow regulations issued by Public Health England.
