- From Saturday 04TH July, some of the pubs in Stourbridge are opened. Malcolm and Carl had a walk round (in plain clothes) to see how things went. Please pray for those working in the pubs, those out socialising and for the SP management team as we think about when and how to resume patrols.
- There has been an increase in crime across the whole of the West Midlands area recently (compared to this time last year), predominantly anti-social behaviour. Stourbridge is showing as one of the worst areas. I'm sure there are all sorts of reasons, but let's pray for the people of our town, some of whom are struggling with work (or lack of), home, money and relationship pressures. Also for the police who have to decide how to prioritise the calls on their
- A long period of change to our normal routines has resulted in many of us thinking about our activities. In the words of the Methodist Covenant service 'let me be employed for you or laid aside for you'.
