LOCKDOWN LIFTING

The Government made the following announcements on Monday 22nd February 2021. During this current lockdown Funerals can continue with up to 30 people. Weddings and Baptisms are only allowed in exceptional circumstances – with numbers limited to 6.

From the 29 March - Funerals can continue with up to 30 people. Weddings will be allowed with up to 6 people.

No earlier than the 12 April Funerals can continue with up to 30 people. Weddings will be allowed with up to 15 people. Baptisms are only allowed in exceptional circumstance and limited to 6 attendees.

No earlier than the 17 May Funerals can continue with up to 30 people. Weddings will be allowed with up to 30 people. Baptisms will be allowed with up to 30 people.

No earlier than the 21 June It is hoped that all legal limits on social contact will be lifted. At this time, we do not know what this will mean for collective worship with regards to social distancing and the use of face masks.

Until we are advised otherwise. we must all continue to follow the rules in place for collective worship. Social distancing both inside and outside Church, the wearing of face coverings, provide contact details for Track and Trace purposes. Only those from one household or support bubble can sit together. You are eligible to form a support bubble with another household of any size if:

- you live by yourself even if carers visit you to provide support,
- you are the only adult in your household who does not need continuous care as a result of a disability.
- your household includes a child who is under the age of one or was under that age on 2 December 2020.
- your household includes a child with a disability who requires continuous care and is under the age of 5 or was under that age on 2 December 2020.
- you are aged 16 or 17 living with others of the same age and without any adults.
- you are a single adult living with one or more children who are under the age of 18 or were under that age on 12 June 2020.
