MASS INTENTIONS

Intention – I apologise for mistakes made recently regarding intentions. Please tick the relevant box on the printed envelopes to indicate whether the Mass in to be offered for the dead or the intentions of the living. **Dates** – If a particular date (or nearest to it) is not requested, there will be a delay of about 3 months before the Mass can be offered in the parish, due to the current back log. Masses requested last November and December are still "waiting" to be offered.

Intentions sent away – I have had several requests from retired priests in the Archdiocese asking if I have any spare Mass intentions. These will be offered within a month of their being received. Please indicate on the envelope if you are happy for these to be sent to them.

LOCKDOWN LIFTING – Although we are nearly entering the next phase of the Government's spring roadmap of lockdown easing, we still need to follow the regulations/guidance we have been issued. Please therefore continue to social distance both outside and inside Church, wear a mask, follow the instructions of our stewards, only sit in same households or support bubbles. The only change for places of worship on the roadmap from the 12th April is that Weddings will be allowed for up to 15 attendees.

HYMN BOOKS AND MASS BOOKS – If anyone has any parish hymns books or any parish mass books, we would be really grateful if you could return them by either bringing them to Mass, leave them in the porch or posting them through the presbytery door. We want to carry out an audit of all books in the parish as we are due to receive our last delivery of Parish Mass books.
