## **RESTARTING PARISH LIFE**

ADULT INSTRUCTION – Due to government restrictions, adult instruction classes did not take place in 2020/21. It is expected that they will be possible later this year. We hope to begin classes in October 2021, which will take place weekly (with the occasional break) until Easter on 4<sup>th</sup> April 2022.

These classes are especially intended for;

- adults who are considering baptism and confirmation and becoming members of the Catholic Church
- adults who are already baptised in other denominations and are considering becoming members of the Catholic Church.
- adults who are already baptised Catholics, but have had little instruction in the Faith.

Anyone who is interested in finding out more about this is asked to contact Fr Philip at the presbytery. When home visits are permitted, he hopes to make individual visits to meet up and talk about the process over the summer.

For the time being, it is vital that anyone considering instruction comes to Mass on Saturday evening/Sunday each week and starts to engage as much as possible in the life of the Church.

**HYMN BOOKS AND MASS BOOKS AMNESTY** – If anyone has any parish hymns books or any parish mass books, we would be really grateful if you could return them by either bringing them to Mass, leave them in the porch or posting them through the presbytery door. We want to carry out an audit of all books in the parish as we are due to receive our last delivery of Parish Mass books.
