To the Parishioners of Kingswinford, Brierley Hill, Old Hill, Halesowen and Stourbridge,

Discussions are currently taking place to restructure the deaneries across the archdiocese, when the deanery of Dudley will be closed. This will be followed by consultations in preparation for parish reorganisation in 2022/2023. We, your parish priests are committing ourselves to working collaboratively and constructively with one another to secure the long-term future of our parish communities. We are confident that this will be a positive experience for everyone. We hope you can support us in this.
