Please note that when the freedom of any Catholic to attend Mass in person is impeded for a serious reason, because of situations such as ill health, care for the sick or legitimate fear, this is not a breach of the Sunday obligation. Our Catholic people and parishes have benefitted during these difficult times from the online streaming of Mass and other services. "Virtual viewing" of Mass online does not fulfil the Sunday obligation. It may, however, be a source of continual spiritual comfort to those who cannot attend Mass in person, for example those who are elderly or sick.

WELCOMING PARISHIONERS TO MASS. - Face coverings are optional, but we would strongly encourage you to wear one whilst in Mass. This is for the protection of others and to make those still anxious feel more comfortable. Some parishioners are only just returning Mass for the first time in 2 years. Some pews will still be closed to give you the option to social distance is you prefer. Please continue to sanitise when you enter Church. Communion will still be given under one kind and our ministers will sanitise and wear masks. The collection baskets will still be at the door, and not taken around during the service

REFRESHMENTS AFTER 11AM SUNDAY MASS – please join us for refreshments in the parish centre. It's wonderful that we can now gather together as we did before the Covid restrictions. This is an opportunity to get to know others in the parish.

MASS INTENTIONS – We are no longer sending Mass intentions elsewhere as Fr Philip and Fr Stephen are both offering Masses every day. Any additional Mass intentions would be appreciated at this time.

CAFOD CLIMATE CHAMPIONS - Sunday 5th of June is UN World Environment Day, and seems a fitting date to begin our journey towards becoming a CAFOD Live Simply Parish. The CAFOD Live Simply Award is an opportunity for Catholic communities to respond to Pope Francis' invitation to "Work with generosity and tenderness in protecting this world which God has entrusted to us." CAFOD have asked for young people aged 18-30 to act as Climate Champions to lead each community on this journey, and Mary O'Brien (who some of you may know as an altar server) has agreed to act in this capacity for Our Lady and All Saints. The first step of the journey is to create a Parish Action Plan involving three types of actions: actions to live simply, actions to live sustainably with creation and actions to live in solidarity with the poor. Many of the things we are already doing in the parish can count towards this, but we also need to begin some new initiatives. A few ideas which we could begin over the coming year include — a parish weekly meat free day; a no new clothes pledge; outdoor seasonal services; a celebration of St Francis (Patron saint of the environment on October 4th); a parish unplugged day; a second-hand clothes and school uniform exchange; walk to church Sunday; weekly green tips on the bulletin.
